EVALUATION CRITERIA

The criteria that will be taken into account by the jury are based on:

- The global knowledge of the authors of risk management (15 points)
- The depth of the proposed analysis or examination (15 points)
- The innovative character of the study (20 points)
- The readability of the paper (10 points)
- The practical aspects, and the facility of implementation, or the direct impact of the work conclusions for professional risk or insurance managers (40 points)

Points mentioned are only indicative as the jury will take a collegial decision. Points have however been approved by the Board of BELRIM as guidelines for the evaluation of the selected works.

The jury will be composed by 5 BELRIM members that will be designated in June 2015.

The jury may call independent experts on the topics concerned. The expert cannot be part of a competing institution. Independent experts have only a consultative intervention.

Important notice: TO BE ELIGIBLE, WORKS MUST BE WRITTEN in ENGLISH, DUTCH or FRENCH only.

There can be no appeal against the selection or evaluation decision made by BELRIM or any of its jury members.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE IN THIS COMPETITION?

The author(s) of the workpaper, end of study work, or thesis must have been students of a recognized Belgian educational institution or school during the academic years 2012-2013, 2013-2014 or 2014-2015. The author(s) must have succeeded his/her studies.

For students of the academic year 2012-2013 only the work-paper, study work or thesis successfully presented in their school after July 15, 2013 can be taken into account.

For students of the academic year 2014-2015, only the workpaper, study work or thesis successfully presented in their school before June 30, 2015 can be taken into account. The competition is open to students of Belgian universities and/or colleges. Students having already started a professional activity are allowed to participate.

The student cannot compete however on his own but must be supported and presented by his/her educational institution or school: **A letter of recommendation** by the Dean of the faculty, institution or school and/or the promotor of the work must be joined to the candidate's file.

WHAT ARE THE AUTHORIZED SUBJECTS

The **main part** of the workpaper or thesis must be related to risk or insurance management topics.

There is no topic limitation to any academic sector :

As examples only, main topics could be :

- Legal aspects of the risk management and/or insurances,
- Regulations,
- Quantitative aspects (stochastics, databases, ...),
- Qualitative aspects,
- Operational risks (human, technology, environment, market/commercial, cyber, supply chain,...),
- Financial risks.
- Human risks
- Environmental risks
- Prevention (human, technical, organisational,...),
- Insurance products,
- Processes (risk identification, risk control, risk transfer, ERM, ...),

There is no topic limitation to any industrial sector :

As examples only, main topics can be related to:

- Industrial risks,
- Financial institutions,
- Services.
- Country risks,
- Public affairs, ...

PRESELECTION

A preselection file must be presented to the Belrim scientific committee **before January 1st, 2015.**

At this stage, it is not necessary for the workpaper, study or thesis to be finalized.

The preselection file (only accepted in English, French or Dutch) includes:

- The identification sheet of the student and of the institution
- The recommendation letter of the institution/promotor
- A brief summary (maximum two pages A4 format) of the paper that highlights the link between the workpaper and risk management.
- The anticipated table of content of the work.

If necessary, students can always withdraw from the competition at any time.

Important notice: Winning workpaper, study or thesis will be made available to BELRIM members on the BELRIM internet site: www.belrim.com. If confidentiality is required, a management summary is accepted for publication.

Only preselected files will be presented to the jury in the final award process.





PRIZES

The BELRIM prize will be awarded to a workpaper, study or thesis that puts its emphasis on the practical aspects, the facility of implementation, or the direct impact of the work conclusions for professional risk or insurance managers.

The prize consists of:

- A free entrance and participation in the European FERMA forum 2015 in Venice (for an example of the forum see the website of the 2013 European FERMA forum at http://www.ferma.eu/ferma-forum-2013/)
- The flights Brussels-Venice –Brussels and hotel accommodations during the period of the forum in Venice.
- A free BELRIM membership for 1 year funtil June 2016)

The scientific committee may add any additional prizes in function of its contacts with the sponsors.

In such cases, the announcement will be made to preselected candidates and on the BELRIM website.
