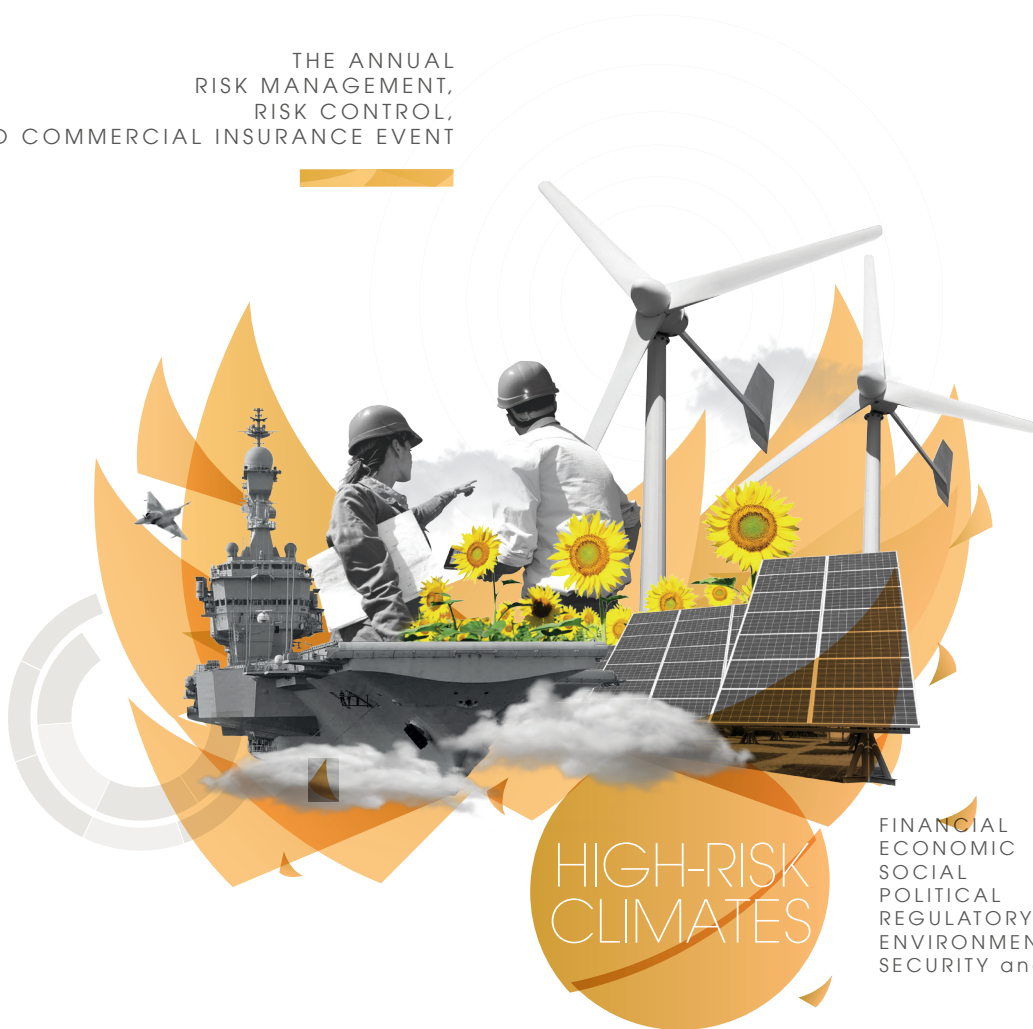

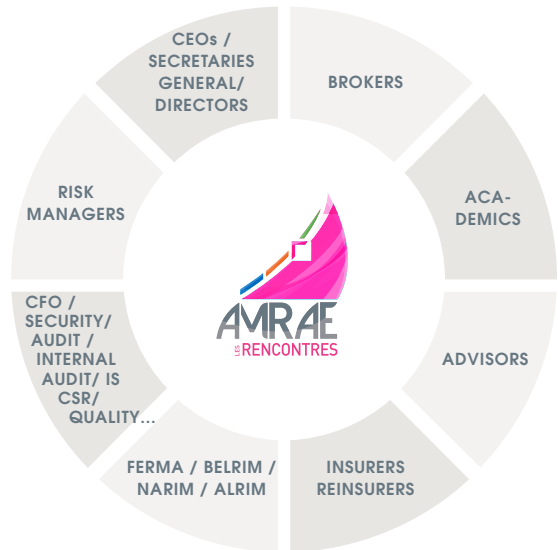

HIGH-RISK CLIMATES

Climate change is a warning sign of systemic risks that generate extreme impacts.

Water, raw materials and energy sources are becoming scarce and some natural resources are overexploited or even plundered. Is the quest for growth inexorably leading to a disproportionate utilisation of the planet's natural resources, sometimes at the expense of the world's poorest? The climate imbalances caused devastate entire populations and wipe out any hope of economic expansion - so is it possible to maintain hope for young people deprived of a future in the face of extremist ideologies?

Isn't it time to realise the planet's natural limitations and the systemic nature of the risks that are facing both it and us?

Because economic globalisation and information technologies have accelerated interdependencies, the impacts are now immediate and extreme in their scope.

Nations are powerless due to a lack of resources. Businesses are also very exposed and need to completely reinvent their model to avoid going under. Paradoxically, aside from their financial purpose, they also bear the seed of ideas and have the lifeblood needed for a new way of living together.
